If the correct test level is not showing, the skater can edit the level on their personal information page and then select the correct event level. The coach must confirm your entry to be accepted.

During the lessons, the instructor will help the skater select the appropriate level and event in which to compete, schedule tests (for a small additional charge), and they will put together the necessary routine.
