General Competition Information

The Dallas Figure Skating Club is hosting the SW NINE STATES Championship in conjunction with the 2017 Southwestern Regional Figure Skating Championship to be held at the Plano Dr. Pepper Starcenter in Plano, Texas. We are planning for a wonderful week of skating, and hope the following information will answer your questions.

Events Included

PRE-JUVENILE, OPEN PRE-JUVENILE, OPEN JUVENILE, PRELIMINARY, PRE-PRELIMINARY, *¹LIMITED PRE-PRELIMINARY, *²NO TEST WELL-BALANCED PROGRAM FREE SKATE, AND PRE-PRELIMINARY THROUGH SENIOR TEST TRACK LEVELS.

- *1Limited Pre-Preliminary has the same requirements as Pre-Preliminary except NO Axel jumps allowed.
- *2No Test is not a Basic Skills event and requires a full US Figure Skating membership.

Rules / Conduct / Eligibility

The SW NINE STATES Championship will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of the U.S. Figure Skating, as set forth in the 2016-17 Official U.S Figure Skating Rulebook. This competition is open to all eligible members of U.S. Figure Skating in good standing in accordance with rule number 3060(a). Skaters may compete in events according to their test level as of September 1, 2016. Pre-Juvenile, Open Pre-Juvenile, Preliminary Pre-Preliminary, Limited Pre-Preliminary, and No Test skaters will be grouped by age. Open Juvenile skaters will be grouped by random draw. If entries warrant, a final round free skate will be held for the following Well-Balanced Free Skate events: Pre-Preliminary, Pre-Juvenile events if time permits.

All events will be judged using the 6.0 system of judging.

Age Requirements

All age requirements will be those stated in the current U.S. Figure Skating rule book using September 1, 2016, as the cut-off date.

Test Requirements

Test requirements must also be met by **September 1, 2016**. Provisional entries based on passing a test after the closing date of entries will not be accepted. Please refer to U.S. Figure Skating Rules 2421 and 2422 for further testing information and guidelines.

Arena Details

The competition will be held at the Plano Dr. Pepper Starcenter, located in Plano, Texas at 4020 W Plano Parkway, Plano, TX 75093. Both ice surfaces are 200' x 85' with rounded corners. The Plano Dr. Pepper Starcenter is considered a cold rink, so be sure to bring warm clothing. Locker rooms will be available for competitor use.

Deadline Date for Entries

The entry deadline is 11:59 p.m., September 1, 2016. Entries will NOT be accepted late. No refunds, NOT EVEN FOR MEDICAL, will be made after September 1, 2016, unless no competition exists in that event. There will be a \$25.00 fee for checks returned for non-sufficient funds. The competition committee reserves the right to limit entries or cancel events based on time restrictions.

NO LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DEADLINE! NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE!

Important Notice for All Coaches

All coaches must comply with the Coach Compliance requirements in order to be allowed to instruct or coach at all qualifying competitions. See rule MR 5.11 located in the 2016-17 U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook for details on the requirements.

Coaches will need to check in at the event registration desk and show proof of registration plus membership in both U.S. Figure Skating and PSA in order to receive a credential. Each local organizing committee (LOC) will ask to see each coach's registration and membership cards at check in. A list of all coaches who have successfully registered will be available at

Entry Fees

Singles Events All Levels: \$175.00

Registration entries must be submitted through Entryeeze with payment via secured credit card transaction. See <u>southwestninestates.org</u> for link. Entryeeze will open for registration 7/15/2016 and close 9/1/2016. Once entries have been closed, entry fees are only refundable if the competition is not held in accordance with rule number 3047.

Registration Desk

The official Registration Desk, located in the front entrance of the Plano Dr. Pepper Starcenter, will be open one hour before the first practice ice session, and will remain open throughout the championship. Competitors must register promptly upon arrival. Credentials and information packets will be handed to competitors upon receipt of the competitor's music. Coaches must register in person to receive their credentials. They are required to be current members of both U.S. Figure Skating and PSA and to show proof of coach's registration.

Official Announcements

The Official Bulletin Board will be in the upstairs ballet room of the Plano Dr. Pepper Starcenter. The Official Schedule of Events will be posted on the Official Bulletin Board and will supersede all other schedules. It is the responsibility of each competitor to check the Official Bulletin Board for event or schedule changes. Skating orders will be posted at the start of the first official practice ice session. Skaters must check in with the Ice Monitor and be ready to compete 45 minutes prior to their scheduled event.

Awards

Medals will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth place winners in all events. Trophies will be awarded to Pre-Juvenile, Preliminary and Pre-Preliminary final round winners if number of entries warrant and time permits for final rounds to be held. All awards will be presented off-ice at the photographer's stand following each event.

Music

Competitors must provide music for all events, as appropriate.

Competition music for all events that require music must be submitted electronically via the online registration system by the music deadline of 9/16/2016 at 11:59 pm via Entryeeze.

After you have paid for your events, the system will prompt you to upload your music for each event that requires music. If your music is not available at that time, you can logout of your account and return later to upload your music by going to the "competition" tab and then selecting "my music".

Your music must meet the following criteria. If you have questions about what format you have, please contact your coach and get a new version of your music that meets the criteria listed below.

Music Criteria:

- File Format: **MP3** (the online system will automatically check this)
- **Bit Rate: 192 kbps** or higher (this will be checked by the music chairperson and they may request you upload a corrected file)
- Sample Rate: 44,100 kHz (this will be checked by the music chairperson and they may request you upload a corrected file)
- Leaders and trailers (the silence or "dead space" before and after the actual start and end of the program music) may not exceed two (2) seconds. We prefer that there be NO leaders or trailers at all. Excessive leaders and trailers may disrupt the playing of the music during competition.

Competitor's practice ice CDs are to be turned in to the Ice Monitor just prior to the competitor's official practice. The official back up competition music CD turned in at the Registration Desk is for use during the event and may not be retrieved for Practice Ice use.

Music Do's and Don'ts

- Have a separate CD for practice and competition, and for each competitive program.
- A duplicate CD should be readily available at event time.
- Single track CDs only. No CD-RWs.
- CDs must be clearly marked with competitor's name, event, and running time of music.

Music may be picked up at the registration table following each event.

Every reasonable care will be taken, but the Dallas Figure Skating Club cannot be responsible for CDs left at the end of the competition.

A duplicate CD should be readily available rink side at time of event.

CREDENTIALS

Each athlete will receive complimentary credentials for 1 chaperone and 1 designated approved coach.

The credentials are marked with the individual's name and are non-transferable. You must have credentials to enter The Plano Dr. Pepper StarCenter. One additional chaperone and coach credentials may be purchased at the registration desk or on Entryeeze. Additional chaperone and coach credentials badges are \$25.

At the time of registration, each competitor will receive their credential badges for themselves and their chaperone(s). The competitor's coach will pick up their credential badge separately at check-in.

A photo ID must be shown by all chaperones and coaches when the credential is picked up. BADGES are non-transferable!

Badges must be worn at all times while in The Plano Dr. Pepper StarCenter. Any lost badges will be replaced for an additional charge of \$30 per badge.

Merchandise

Event merchandise, souvenir pins, will be available for purchase at the arena for \$10, or for pre-purchase at the reduced price of \$6. Go to the event website located at <u>southwestninestates.org</u> to place your order through Entryeeze.

The SW NINE States Championship will be open to the public at a cost of <u>\$15/day</u> PER PERSON or \$35 PER PERSON for <u>the length of the entire competition</u>

Each skater will receive one competitor credential and one chaperone credential included with their registration. NO CREDENTIAL WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT PHOTO ID. Tickets and additional credentials can be purchased at the Registration Desk or online at southwestninestates.org

Program Information

It is in your best interest to pre-purchase your program, as there will be a limited availability at the event. Also, **pre-purchased programs** will be offered at the reduced price of \$10. Photographs are permitted for personal use only, but for the safety of the skaters NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY is allowed. Any resale of photography is strictly prohibited. Thank you for your compliance with these policies.

Transportation

There are two main airports to fly in to Dallas. DFW International Airport is located 22 miles west of the rink and will take approximately 27 minutes via car from the rental pick up counter.

Loves Field is located 19 miles southwest of the rink and will take approximately 30 minutes from the rental counter.

Please keep in mind that I-35 is under major construction and you will need to allow extra time for the traffic delays

Dates and Schedules

Practice ice is scheduled to begin on Saturday, October 8, 2016. The competition is scheduled for Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday, October 8-10, 2016. The tentative schedule is included within this announcement. The official schedule will be posted on the event website, <u>southwestninestates.org</u>, when it is available. Please check the web site often for updates and the most current information.

Practice Ice

See event website located at <u>southwestninestates.org</u> for Practice Ice Session details and Entryeeze link. Schedule for practice times will be posted in Entryeeze by 9/19/2016.

Practice ice will be sold in 20 minute sessions. All practice ice fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

PRE-SALE Practice Ice UNOFFICIAL Sessions are \$20 online via Entryeeze during registration for competition. Maximum 2 unofficial practice ice sessions per skater / per day during pre-sale - deadline **9/1/2016.**

UNOFFICIAL Practice Ice Sessions will be scheduled throughout the event - NO music will be played. Selection of exact day and time for pre-sale Unofficial Practice Ice 9/21/2016 thru 9/27/2016.

PRE-SALE Practice Ice OFFICIAL Sessions are \$20 online via Entryeeze during registration for competition. Each competitor is allowed to purchase ONE OFFICIAL Practice Ice Session PER event. OFFICIAL Practice Ice Sessions will be scheduled *by the competition*. Skaters will be notified by email of the time of their official practice. An extra CD copy of music is needed to be played on the OFFICIAL Practice Ice Session.

OPEN BUY Practice Ice Sessions available for purchase 9/28/2016 thru 10/4/2016 via Entryeeze for \$20.

Beginning 10/5/2016, ALL Practice Ice Sessions are \$25 per 20-minute session sold only at the Practice Ice Desk in the lobby of the Plano Dr. Pepper StarCenter. The Practice Ice Desk will open one hour before the first practice ice session and will be open throughout the competition to sell additional practice ice *as available*. If there is a waiting line, then practice ice may be purchased for only one skater at a time.

PREMIUM WARM-UP ICE on the day of competition is \$20 per 15-minute session sold only at the Practice Ice Desk in the lobby of the Plano StarCenter.

If the event time is available to accommodate practice ice for Final Rounds, a notice will be posted on the Official Bulletin Board at the competition.

Official Practice indicates a practice session with time reserved for music to be played for the skater one time during the practice session. Skaters must bring an extra CD copy of music to be used on official practice. Each competitor is allowed to purchase 1 official practice session per event. Official Practices will be scheduled by the competition. Competitors must pre-purchase official practice time during registration for the competition before 9/1/2016. Schedule for practice times will be posted by in Entryeeze by 9/19/2016, and skaters will be notified by email of the time of their official practice.

Unofficial Practice Ice will be scheduled throughout the event. Music will not be played for unofficial sessions. Skaters may pre-purchase unofficial practice sessions up to 2 sessions per skater/per day during entry for the competition. Skaters who pre-purchase unofficial practice ice will have the opportunity to select their practice times beginning 9/21/2016 thru 9/27/2016. Any remaining practice sessions available after 9/27/2016 will be sold online thru Entryeeze until competition begins. Once competition begins practice ice will only be handled in person at the Practice Ice desk.

EVENT: Introductory Levels Free Skate Program - No Test Levels/Limited Pre-Preliminary/Open Pre-Juvenile/Open Juvenile

General event parameters:

- 1. Skaters will skate to the music of their choice. Vocal music is permitted at all levels.
- 2. Level will be determined by the highest free skate test passed. Skaters may compete at the highest level they have passed, or skate up to one level higher.
- 3. Minimum number of spin revolutions are in parentheses following the spin description. Revolutions must be in position.

COMPETITIVE TEST TRACK – FREE SKATE EVENTS

Skaters may enter EITHER the new test track free skate program or the well-balanced track free skate program but NOT both during the same non-qualifying competition. Competitors will skate to music of their choice, vocal music permitted.

Deductions WILL be made for skaters including technical elements not permitted in the event description. Note: Competitive Test Track skaters are allowed to skate up one level during this event.

- 0.1 from EACH mark for each technical element included that is not permitted in the event description.
- 0.2 from the technical mark for each extra or lacking element.
- 0.1 for any spin with less than required revolutions.
