COMPETITION INFORMATION

ENDORSEMENT:

Endorsed by the Ice Skating Institute.

COMPETITION DATES:

Sunday, November 12, 2017.

ENTRIES:

All applications must be completed on Entryeeze by Saturday, October 7, 2017. The entry fee is \$350 per team, per Free Skate event. The entry fee does not include practice ice.

REFUND POLICY:

Entry fees will not be refunded after close of entries on October 7, 2017 unless the competition is canceled. Contested credit card charges will be assessed a \$25 fee. Payment of the fee will be required before the team is allowed to participate in practice ice or events.

ELIGIBILITY:

All skaters entering this competition must be registered individual members of ISI. Events are offered to all ages - Tots through Adults. All participating teams must be registered with the ISI office and have a valid team number for the 2017-2018 skating season.

RULES:

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the guidelines contained in the 2017 ISI Handbook.

JUDGING:

All coaches with teams competing in our events must be a current ISI Professional Member. All participating rinks are required to supply an appropriate number of certified judges. Judge certification tests can be taken online at the ISI website (<u>www.skateisi.org</u>) Please see the 2017 ISI Handbook. All professional memberships and judge certification will be verified by ISI. <u>The judges will be seated in the hockey team</u> <u>area on the west side of the rink, on the opposite side of the stands.</u>

MUSIC AND REGISTRATION:

All teams are to check in at the registration desk at least **1 hour** prior to their scheduled event. If the competition is running ahead of schedule, an event may begin earlier than its scheduled time. Please turn in your program CD at that time. Only CDs will be accepted. CDs are to be clearly labeled with the team's name, event, level, rink and/or club they are representing. There should be no more than one program on a CD.

RINK SIZE:

Ice surface is 200' by 85' with rounded corners.

AWARDS:

All skaters will receive an award. Awards will be presented upon the posting of each event.

ACCOUNTING REVIEW:

Accounting review requests can be made by an ISI Professional Member to the Competition Director. Judges scores are considered final; a review is simply a verification of these scores. There will be a \$50.00 fee for all reviews. If an error is found, the fee will be refunded.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

A preliminary schedule of events and judge's sign-up sheet will be sent to each participating rink.

ADMISSION:

Credentials for team coaches, team competitors, and 2 team managers will be provided to allow access to the locker rooms during the event. There will be a \$10.00 admission fee for spectators.

PRACTICE ICE:

Once the competition schedule has been completed, teams will be notified by e-mail of any practice ice that is available. Unofficial practice ice will be sold on Saturday in one hour increments for \$525.00 per hour. Unofficial practice ice will be sold on Friday, November 10th for \$425.00 per hour before 4:00 pm. DESCRIPTION OF EVENTS

SYNCHRONIZED COMPULSORIES - Formation / Skating

Synchronized Formation and Skating teams must perform 4 or 5 required elements to music, with no additional moves permitted. Teams will be divided by age groups. For details of compulsory maneuvers and program duration limitations, please see the current 2017 edition of the ISI Handbook.

SYNCHRONIZED TEAM – Dance / Formation / Skating

This is a group number for 8 or more skaters to perform in unison. They can incorporate various skating formations such as circles, pinwheels, lines, footwork sequences and dance steps. New Advanced Formation and Open Skating events have been introduced. For complete description of Formation, Skating, and Dance categories, please see 2017 edition of ISI Handbook.

PRODUCTION

This team event is for groups of 8 or more skaters. Teams will be judged on the performance value of the program. There are no required maneuvers and no technical score for this event. The group should use music along with elaborate costumes and props to enhance the theme while creating an entertaining performance. Skaters from all levels can participate in this event. Event entries will be divided into Small / Medium / Large / Extravaganza categories, as registration warrants.
