General Rules and Information

San Diego Figure Skating Club's *Skate La Grande, San Diego – Special Skater* will be an open competition held June 29-July 1, 2018, at the San Diego Ice Arena, 11048 Ice Skate Place, San Diego, CA 92126. The competition will be held in conjunction with the San Diego Figure Skating Club's *Skate La Grande, San Diego* open US Figure Skating competition and will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the US Figure Skating as set forth in the **current Rulebook**, except as specified in this announcement.

Entry Deadline: The close of entries is Monday, May 29, 2018. Entries must be received (not postmarked) by the registrar not later than midnight, Monday, May 29, 2018. Late entries received after Monday, May 29, 2018 may be accepted at the discretion of the Skate La Grande LOC.

Events to be Skated: The following events will be offered: Freestyle Levels 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6, and Showcase Levels 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6. Skaters must be 2017-18 season members of US Figure Skating, ISI, or Special Olympics.

Tests: Test qualification as of the close of entries shall determine eligibility.

Registration: A Registration Desk will be located in the lobby of the San Diego Ice Arena on the days of the competition. All competitors are required to register upon arrival at the arena, no later than 45 minutes before the scheduled start of their event.

Note: *At the discretion of the referee, events may begin up to 20 minutes prior to the published tentative schedule.*

Bulletins and Notices: An official bulletin board will be maintained at the Registration desk and at www.skatelaGrande.org. It is the responsibility of each competitor, parent and coach to check in with Registration frequently for any schedule changes and/or additional information. The posting of notices on the official bulletin board shall be considered sufficient advance notice to all competitors.

Eligibility: Skaters will NOT be eligible to compete without a current **2017-18 season membership**. Most memberships are renewed/applied for through a home figure skating club. Please contact your club's membership chair for any questions or concerns.

Entry Fees: Entry fees should be made payable to the "San Diego Figure Skating Club" or "SDFSC". The entry fees are:

Note: There is a \$25 charge for returned checks

Refund of Entry Fees: After the close of entry date of Monday, May 29, 2018 refunds will only be issued if the competition is not held, in accordance with US Figure Skating rule #3047.

Entries: Entry forms must be completely filled out and properly signed by the skater's coach and mailed with the appropriate entry fees to: **NOTE: Incomplete entries will be returned.**

Hotel accommodations are available at a discounted rate. Reservations must be made prior to May 31, 2018 to receive the discount.

Music: Music will be played by CD. Skaters should have an extra copy of their music (on CD) with them in the arena. The CD must have only one track. **Multi-track CDs will not be played.** The CD must be labeled with the competitor’s name and event. We are able to play CD-R.

Video Taping and/or Photography: Due to contractual agreement with our videographer, videotaping is limited to taping of your own skater. Additionally, for the safety of all skaters, flash photography is not permitted in the arena at any time.

Grouping of events: Any event may be divided into groups at the discretion of the referee. No final rounds will be skated for events that are divided.

Awards: Awards will be given for *all* placements for Special Skater events.

Special Awards:

The Peggy Stark Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the skater judged as having performed the most outstanding program. The trophy is being awarded to honor the memory of Peggy Stark and her many years of devoted service to the sport of figure skating and her work with special athletes. Peggy was a member of the San Diego Figure Skating Club for over 50 years and served in many positions including President, Board Member, Committee Chair, and as a US Figure Skating Judge. The perpetual trophy, with winner’s name engraved will remain on display at the San Diego Figure Skating Club. A suitable engraved personal keepsake will be presented to the winner.

Special Award Previous Winners: Competitors are not eligible to win the Peggy Stark Memorial Trophy in consecutive years.

Ice Surface: The San Diego Ice Arena has an ice surface of 200’ x 85’ with slightly rounded corners.

Practice Ice: Depending on the number of applicants, practice ice for the competition may be offered through the competition committee. If offered, final details for scheduling practice ice will be made available to competitors through Entryeeze on or near June 15, 2018. Special Skater Events

The Skate La Grande, San Diego will consist of four sections: U.S. Figure Skating events, Showcase events, Compete USA events and Special Skater events.

Events are open to all eligible persons registered with U.S. Figure Skating. The 2018 Skate La Grande, San Diego will be conducted in accordance with current U.S. Figure Skating Rules and Standards except as noted in this Announcement. Official notices and bulletins will be posted on the official bulletin board at the Registration desk and on the Skate La Grande competition website (www.skatelagrande.org).

Showcase Events

Showcase Events – Basis of Judging:

All entry qualifications must be attained as of May 29, 2018. Those eligible under U.S. Figure Skating Rules, reinstated skaters and representatives of other governing bodies may compete.

- a. Performances will be judged for theatrical and artistic qualities, from an entertainment standpoint.
- b. Technical skating skill and difficulty will not be rewarded as such; however, skating must be the major element of the performance and of sufficient quality to support the theatrical elements chosen.
- c. *Unintended falls, poorly executed skating elements and obvious losses of control will reduce contestant's marks.*
- d. Jump difficulty is not rewarded in showcase, therefore jumps, if choreographed, should be those performed with style, flow and confidence. Jumps should not be used but as the choreography requires.
- e. Theatrical elements evaluation will include: Energy, poise, acting, pantomime, eye contact, choreography, form, extension and the use of costumes, ice and props.
- f. One performance mark incorporating the 6.0 scoring system will be assigned each performance by each judge. No technical skating mark will be used. Any overtime penalties will be posted with the results.
