COVID-19 COMPETITION SERIES POLICY

Subject to Change based on State and Local Guidelines

BUILDING POLICY:

- 1. Everyone entering the building must check in and check out for time tracking purposes.
- 2. Please use proper Enter & Exit doors while navigating the arena.
- 3. All skaters, parents, volunteers, and coaches are <u>required</u> to wear a mask upon entering the arena. Per Governor Walz executive order: "Youth 2 years of age and under do not have to wear a mask, and youth 2-5 years old are encouraged to wear a face covering, but not required to".
 - a. Skaters must wear masks at all times, on and off the ice.
 - b. Masks <u>must</u> be worn correctly. If worn incorrectly (not covering nose and mouth) you may be asked to wear it correctly or to leave the arena.
 - c. Sheer masks are not allowed
- 4. Only two spectators are allowed with a skater and may only enter the arena at time of their child's event. The spectators will be escorted to and from viewing position.
 - a. No outside spectators allowed competition.
 - b. See Section II for more details of parent/guardian competition details.

- 5. Due to Governor Walz executive order: No locker rooms will be allowed. Skaters will be escorted to assigned benches to put their skates on.
 - a. If the skater needs help putting skates on, you must do so outside of the arena area as no parents/guardians are allowed within the arena until events begin.
 - b. Coaches may help put skates on.
 - c. Please be sure to only bring what is absolutely necessary into the arena to keep spaces as open as possible.
 - d. There is no changing allowed. Events are placed back to back to minimize the amount of time each skater is in the arena.
- 6. No outside food or beverages allowed with the exception of water brought from home.
 - a. Drinking fountains will not be available
 - b. Concessions may be available if State/Local/and Arena guidelines are permitting.
- Bathrooms are for use of skaters, coaches and judges only. This helps minimize traffic
 and sanitation purposes. An exterior bathroom OR one set bathroom will be for
 volunteers/ parents/guardians IF absolutely needed.
 - a. No changing allowed in bathrooms.

AWARDS:

- 1. Awards will be done socially distanced or in a separate area from the arena to allow Parent(s)/Guardian(s) to take photos.
 - a. Masks MUST be worn while on the podium/accepting the awards.
 - b. Each event must exit the awards area (if indoors) within 10 minutes to avoid gathering for an extended period of time and keep the flow of the competition running smoothly.
- 2. Each medal will be in a separate bag for each skater to pick up.
- 3. Event Placement will be posted online and will be able to be seen at the medal pick up area.

MUSIC:

1. Music will only be accepted in digital form. NO CD'S accepted.

EVENTS:

- 1. Each group will have NO MORE than 6 skaters per group.
- 2. Interpretive will have NO MORE than 6 skaters per group and each group will receive a different song.
- 3. Spins have been removed from this year's Series. Compulsory and Freeskate are offered at all remaining Series comps and Interpretive at select competitions.

SECTION II: PARENTS/GUARDIANS COMPETITION DAY- Step by Step

- 1. Arrive to competition at scheduled time.
- 2. Check your skater in.
 - a. Once all skaters in a group are checked in the skaters will be escorted to their benches inside. Parents will wait in designated waiting areas
 - b. Once your skaters group is warming up for their event The parent(s)/guardian(s) will be escorted into the arena to the assigned viewing area.
- 3. Skaters will compete their Compulsory and Freeskate back to back. Once your skaters Freeskate group is complete All parents/guardians will be escorted out of the arena back to the designated awards table.
- 4. **IF** awards are located in the same space as the designated waiting area you must leave the area immediately following the end of awards.

COACHES:

- 1. Coaches are only allowed in the arena IF they have students competing.
 - a. If your skaters are done and you have a break of more than 45 minutes- you must exit the arena until your next skater enters.
 - b. Coaches will be required to follow the same policies listed above.
 - Coaches may help skaters with their skates if needed on the assigned benches.

Final COVID-19 Policy will be released no later than 1 week prior to each competition. Please be aware that the above may not be final. When the final policy comes out - the above will be inactive.
