TRANSPORTATION

The Olympic Center (OCN) and hotels are very close and it is a short walk between the two.

The distance is 0.11 miles or 0.17 km, 3 to 5 minutes walking time.

NO shuttle will be provided.

The Transportation desk is located on the 2nd floor in the Olympic Center Conference Center (OCN). Information regarding transportation needs and attending other events can be obtained here.

ATHLETE DINING

Athlete dining at the Main Dining Hall will be on the second (2nd) floor of the Olympic Center Conference Center (OCN) from 7-24 January 2023. The first meal will be provided on 7 January for lunch at 12:00. The last meal will be provided on 24 January until 10:30.

ATHLETES LOUNGE: The athletes' lounge will have snacks and beverages provided from the start of the first official training day on 11 January.

Access to the lounge in the Ice Rink is open to all Accreditation Card holders who have permission to enter. Priority will be given to competitors. Please, do not take food from the athlete's lounge, as its safety cannot be guaranteed if not stored properly!

The lounge is located in the USA Rink adjacent to the 1980 Herb Brooks Arena

ACCREDITATION AND SECURITY

Accreditation cards will be given to all officially entered teams' members of the skating family. Please always carry these Accreditation cards in the Ice Rink and in the Hotel. Access to various locations will be controlled.

LOST ACCREDITATION CARD

If an Accreditation Card is lost, athletes and delegation officials should immediately contact the respective Accreditation Center for its re-issue and complete the following steps:

The HoD must immediately send an email with the subject line "Lost Credential" to accreditation@lakeplacid2023.com to request a replacement card. The email must contain

the delegation country and the issued name on the lost Accreditation Card. The card will be immediately cancelled, and the delegation can be subjected to a handling fee of \$50 USD.

After the CIC officer confirms the entitlement of the applicant and activates the Accreditation Card, the new card will be available for pickup at the Welcome Center.

- For Ice Dance, all couples will qualify for the Free Dance since there are less than 20 entries in total.

TRAINING (PRACTICE) GROUPS & MUSIC ROTATION

Training at the Olympic Center will take place on 11 and 12 January 2023

Training slots and music rotation are assigned to the skaters on 11 and 12 January. Official practice sessions beginning on 13 Jan will be according to the starting order.

Official training practice groups and music rotation order will be posted at the ice rink and on the EntryEeze website: <http://comp.entryeeze.com/Home.aspx?cid=817>. They will also be distributed to team mailboxes located at the rink in the Athletes' Lounge.

Unofficial training ice for Figure Skating competitors will be available on a limited, self-pay basis (currently USD 20 per person per 50-minute session) at the 1932 Jack Shea Arena in the Olympic Center, through the venue owner/operator.

DATE: 12 January 2023

START: 19:00 – 21:00 (planned duration: 2h)

COMMUNICATIONS

Communications, results, and other information for the Teams/Delegations will be distributed in the teams' boxes at the OCN in the Athlete's Lounge and for the Event Officials in the Technical Panel Room and Judges Room.

A Sport Information Desk will be located in the lobby area immediately inside the Athlete's Entrance to the Olympic Center.

PRESS CONFERENCES

(No press conferences are scheduled at this time)

Should any press conferences be scheduled, all press conferences will take place in the Lussi Room, located on the second floor of the Olympic Center Conference Center.

Mixed Zone

A mixed zone for on-the-spot interviews will be in the lobby area near the Athlete's entrance of the 1980 rink. At the end of a competition, all athletes must leave the Field of Play through the mixed zone where brief interviews will be held. Every athlete/coach should be ready to communicate with media representatives upon their request.

KISS AND CRY AREA

The Kiss & Cry is designated as a special access area. A pass system will be in place for each skater's support staff. Four (4) persons maximum will be allowed into the rink with the skater(s). Two (2) of those persons will be given a Green Supplementary Accreditation Card allowing them to be on the boards and in the Kiss & Cry. The two (2) other support persons will be given a Red Supplementary Accreditation Card allowing them into the rink area but not to enter Kiss & Cry area.

DOPING CONTROL SERVICES

Doping Control services will be carried out in accordance with the WADA World Anti-Doping Code and will be provided under the rules and regulations of FISU. Conditions for doping control procedures will be provided during the competitions at will take place at the ice rink.

The doping control station for Figure Skating athletes will be located in the Olympic Center, one (1) level below the 1980 Herb Brooks Arena. There will be one locker room for the processing station and one for the waiting area, located right across the hall.

DEPARTURES

Departure list will be posted in the Technical Panel Room and the Judges Room at the Olympic Center.

The Organizing Committee will provide departure transportation for all participants flying from the Official Point of Arrival- Albany International Airport

It is kindly asked to confirm with your HoD all details of your departure 48 hours prior to your scheduled departure. If there are changes that were made after the I-Form is completed or changes that are made during the Lake Placid 2023 FISU Games, these changes need to be communicated to the Delegation Services Desk as soon as possible. The Delegation Services Desk will communicate these changes to the proper Functional Areas so they can properly assist you with your departure. The Delegation Services Desk is located on the 2nd floor of the Olympic Center Conference Center.

- All Lake Placid 2023 FISU World University Games participants must be at Albany International Airport **two (2) hours prior to departure.**
- From the Central region Villages, **participants must anticipate three (3) hours to arrive at ALB; this means that there must be a five (5) hours total window prior to one's scheduled departure.**

USEFUL INFORMATION

WEATHER AND CLIMATE

January Climate & Weather Averages in Lake Placid

High Temp: 25 °F (-3° Celsius)

Low Temp: 5 °F (-15° Celsius)

Lake Placid averages 102 inches (259 centimetres) of snow per year. The U.S. average is 28 inches (71 centimetres) of snow per year. Lake Placid gets some form of precipitation, on average, 170 days per year. Precipitation is rain, snow, sleet or hail that falls to the ground. For precipitation to be counted there must be at least 0.01 inches (0.025 centimetres) on the ground to measure. Lake Placid, NY gets 41 inches (104 centimetres) of rain, on average, per year. The U.S. average is 38 inches (96.5 centimetres) of rain per year.

OFFICIAL CURRENCY The United States uses the United States Dollar (USD).

LANGUAGE The United States does not have an official language. However, English is spoken by most Americans.

TIME ZONE Eastern Standard Time-EST

ELECTRICITY In the United States of America, the power plugs and sockets are of type A and B. The standard voltage is 120 V and the standard frequency is 60 Hz. Power plug adapter needed.

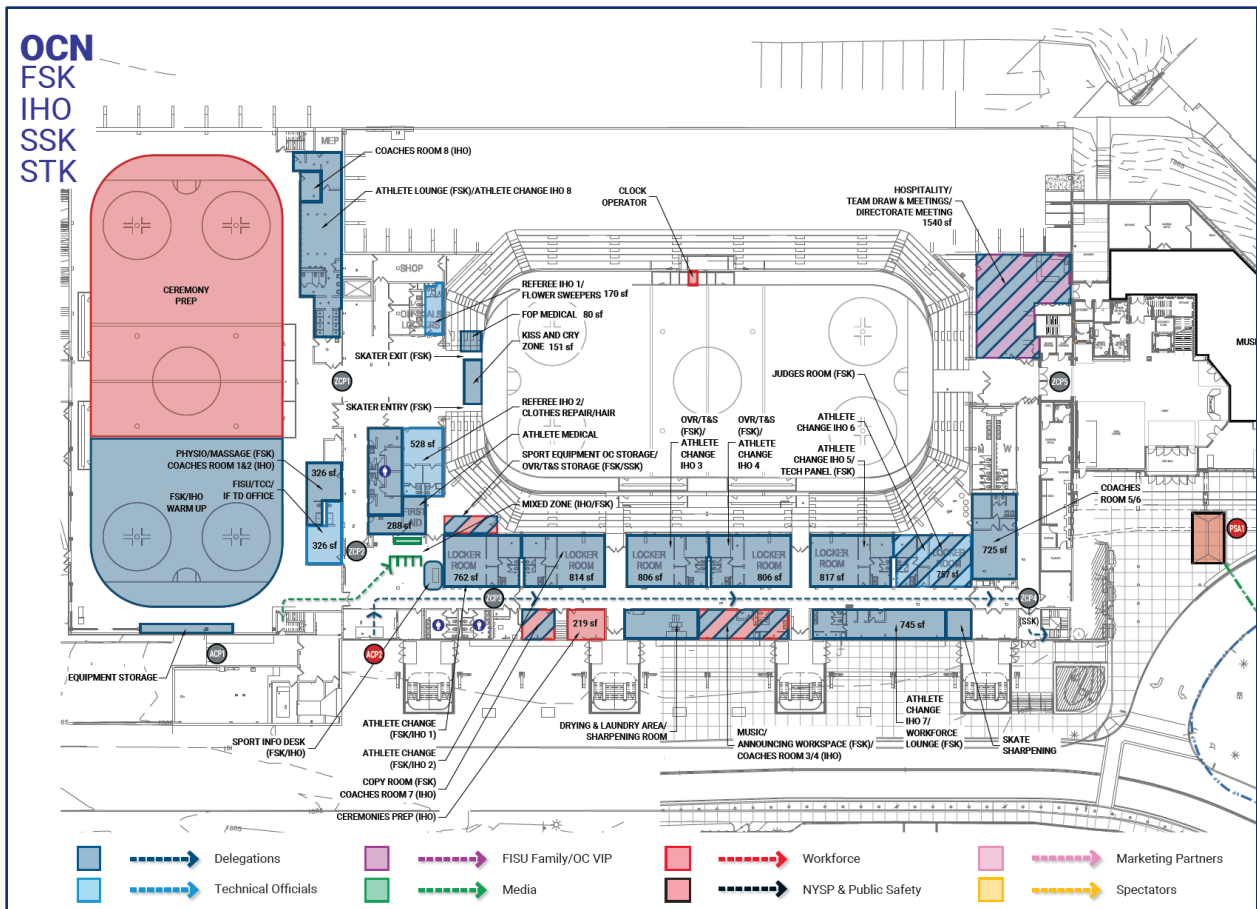

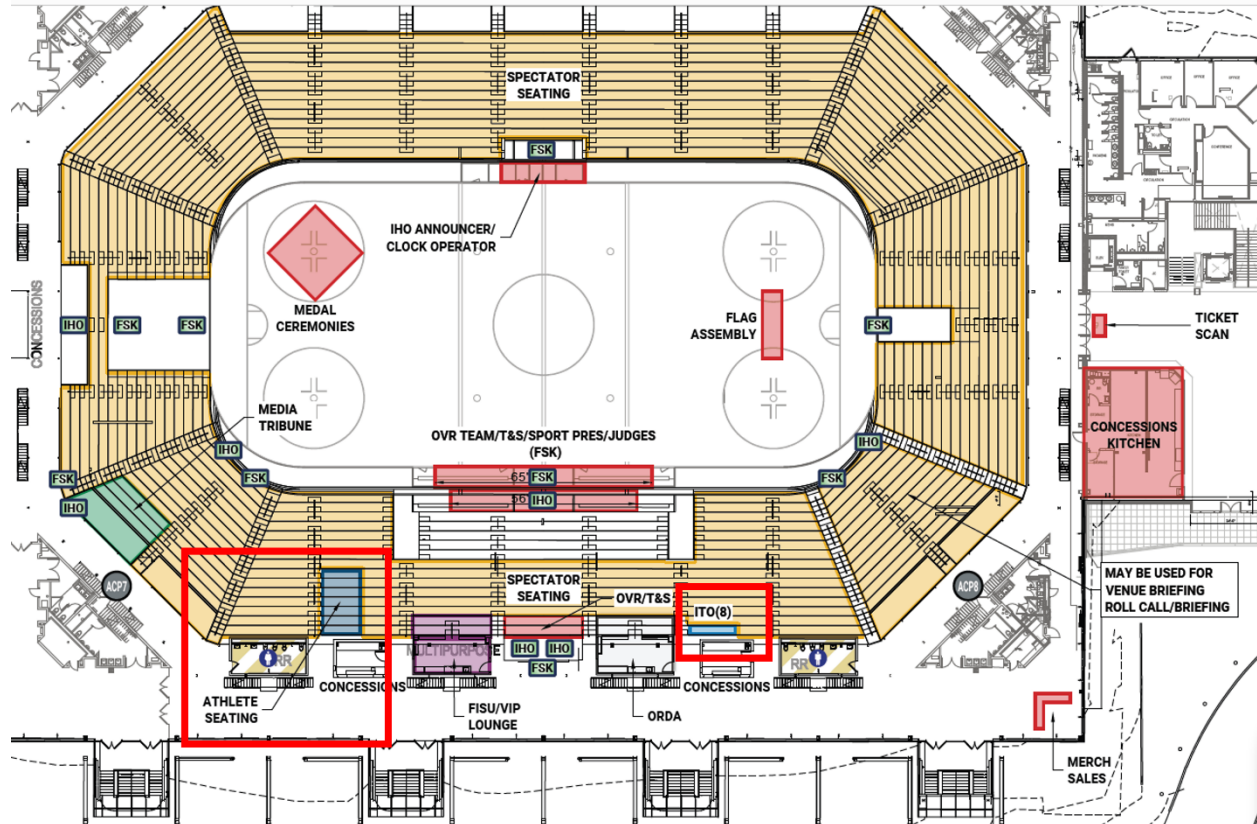
1980 Arena (practice and competition) – Ground Level

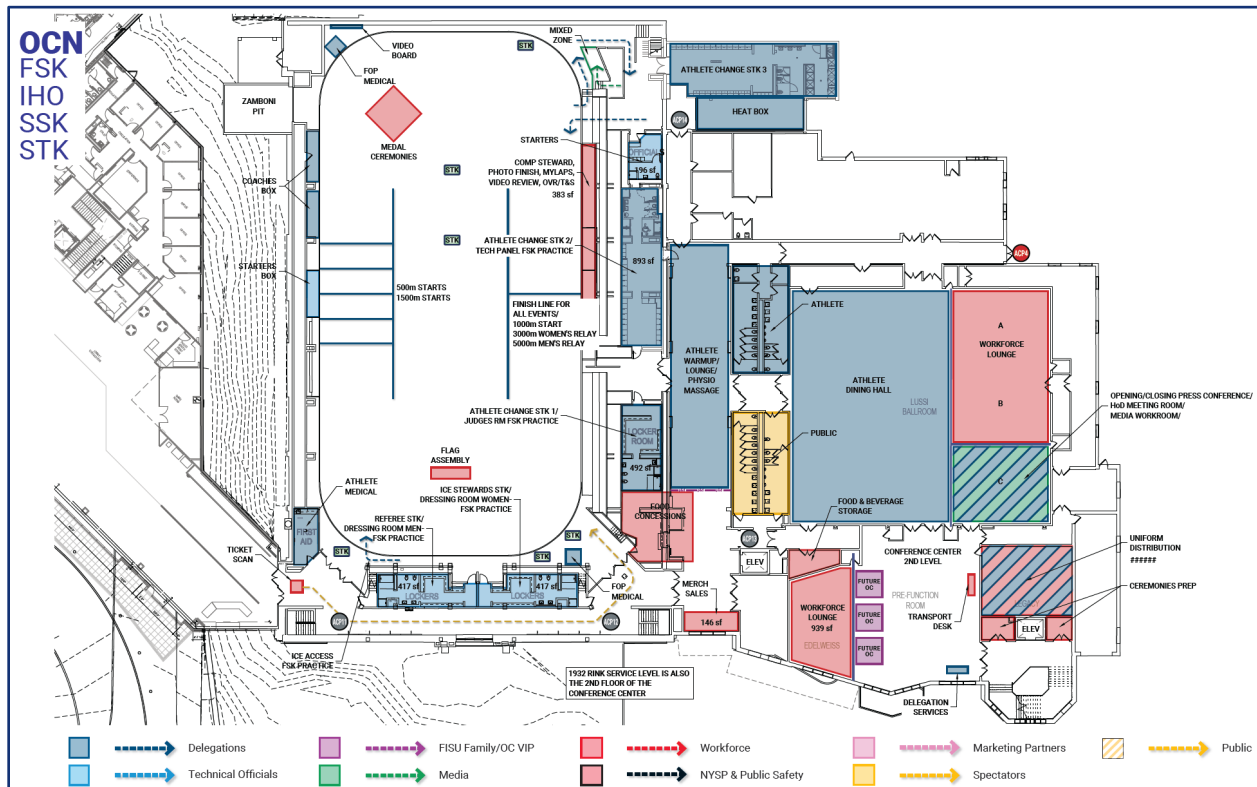
1980 Arena (practice and competition) – Concourse Level

Access to event seating for delegations and ITOs, concessions

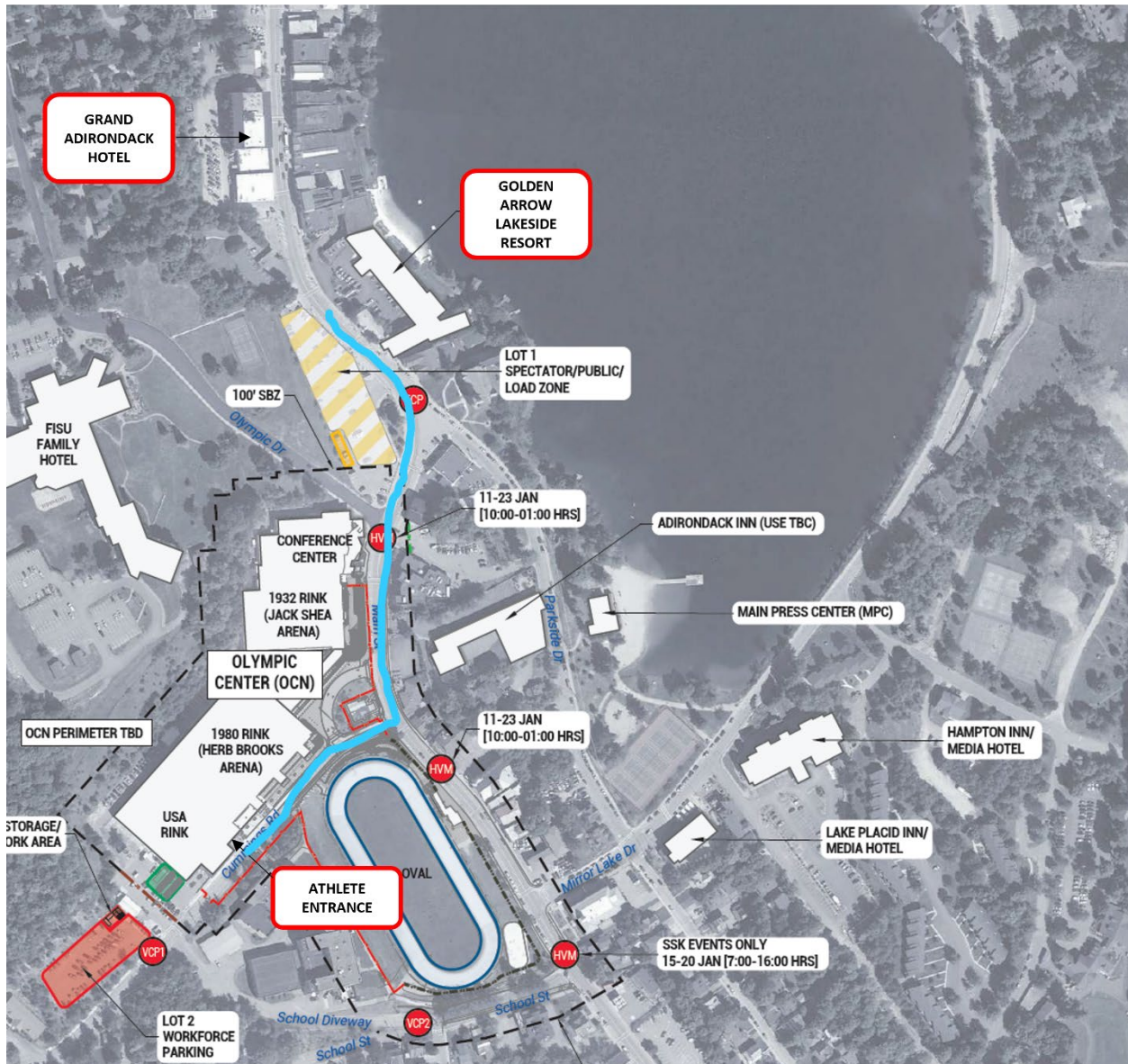


1932 Arena (practice)
