Operations and Safety Plan for Skaters and Coaches

Overall Event

- 1. Masks must always be worn except for Skaters during their programs.
- A mask is defined as a CLOTH covering that completely covers your nose and your mouth AT ALL TIMES. Plastic face shields are not considered masks and will not be accepted without an additional cloth mask. You can view more information on the CDC website on acceptable masks.
- 3. Masks will be required for all people ages 11 and up.
- 4. Masks are required for ALL PEOPLE ENTERING THE BUILDING (no medical exemptions allowed).
- 5. The consequence for not complying with the mask rule will be expulsion from the competition after 2 warnings. This applies to every person entering the facility. If a chaperone, spectator or coach is warned twice, they will be expelled from the building. Please note that this could impact your skater's ability to compete.
- 6. There will be no refunds if you are expelled based on noncompliance of the mask rule.

- 7. You will be required to social distance from all others at a distance of at least 6 feet while inside the building at all times.
- 8. Temperature will be checked prior to entering the facility.
- 9. There will be NO spectators allowed at this Event, other than the Chaperone(s).
- 10. Two (2) chaperones per registered athlete will be admitted for the athlete's actual competition time (no access to practice rink). The chaperones will be one coach and the other must be over the age of 18 and an immediate family member as defined in U.S. Figure Skating's SafeSport Handbook.
- 11. Medals will be awarded outside of the facility in a designated area (weather permitting).
- 12. Come dressed and ready to skate
- 13. Young Athletes or Athletes requiring special assistance, will be allowed one Chaperone to accompany them into the facility for Practice Ice.
- 14. Young Athletes or Athletes requiring special assistance, will be allowed one Chaperone to accompany them into the Warmup Zone at event time to help get skates on. Then the Chaperone must immediately exit the area and move to the designated arena seating.

Pathway for Registration:

1. Registrants will be greeted by an usher outside the facility and directed to the registration table. Once registration is complete, the registrant will leave the area.

Pathway for Skater/Coach for event:

- 1. Skaters will meet in the designated area outside the facility 30 minutes prior to their event.
- 2. Once in the designated area, skaters and coach's temperatures will be taken
- 3. Upon entering the building, they will be escorted to a designated warm up area, weather permitting, off ice warm up will take place outside.
- 4. Skaters will put skates on in a designated socially distanced area in the lobby.
- 5. They will then be moved to the gates to prepare for warm up. There will be designated sites 6 feet apart near the entrance to the rink.
- 6. When their event is called, they will warm up with their masks on.
- 7. They will then leave the ice and return to their marked location to wait for their turn.
- 8. When it is their turn to skate, they will hand their mask to their coach and perform.
- 9. They will exit the ice and may take their skates off inside the locker room where they waited to enter the ice.
- 10. They will all wait in the designated area until the event is complete.

Pathway for Chaperone/Spectator

- 1. Each chaperone/spectator will be greeted by an usher outside at the front of the facility and a temperature check will be taken.
- 2. They will be met by an usher and escorted to the designated waiting area.
- 3. When the previous group moves into the bleachers, an usher will take them to the designated waiting area, prior to entering the stands.
- 4. When their skater's event warms up, they will be escorted into the bleacher area and will choose a designated place to sit. Signs will be posted.

5. When the event has ended, they will be escorted to the lobby to meet their skaters and will immediately leave the building. Chaperone's may use the exit ramps to exit the bleachers, enter the tunnel, and exit the red doors into the lobby.

Pathway for Practice Ice

- 1. Each skater/coach will be greeted by an usher at the front entrance to get a temperature check prior to entering the facility.
- Chaperones/spectators are not allowed at practice ice, except those that are required to have a chaperone per SafeSport policies. If chaperones must enter for practice ice, they will be able to observe from the bleachers.
- 3. Masks will be required at all times during practice ice.
- 4. Skaters/coaches will leave the facility immediately following practice ice. Skaters may sit at the benches to remove their skates.

Pathway for Officials


- 1. Officials will be greeted by an usher at the front of facility to get a temperature check.
- 2. In the hospitality room, officials will have their own designated area that will be socially distanced 6 feet.
- 3. Officials will follow the designated path to enter the rink.
- 4. They will use the entrance to the tunnel to enter the rink from the east end of the facility. An usher will accompany officials to their designated location.
- 5. The officials will be set up in stations 6 feet apart. They will be provided their own blanket for the event. They will be provided their own papers, pens and pencils for the event.
- 6. There will be limited official overlap
- 7. Official's stations will be cleaned between groups.

Hospitality

- 1. Meals will be provided for officials.
- 2. There will be limited official overlap.
- 3. There will be pre-packaged snacks for coaches and volunteers to pick up in the Volunteer and Coach Snack Station (TBD).

Building Access and Layout

Pathways have been established within the building to minimize footprint and socialization between groups. You will not be permitted access to the building until your designated time per the detailed schedule. Athletes who miss their arrival time will be escorted to the appropriate area in accordance with their schedule – cannot 'redo' warm up.



Disinfecting Process

- 1. Warm up areas will be disinfected after each Warmup is completed.
- 2. After each event Segment, Chairs and areas that have been touched by the skaters/coaches will be disinfected.
- 3. The bleacher section the Chaperones used will be disinfected after each segment
- 4. After each Practice Ice, areas that have been touched by the skaters/coaches will be disinfected.

Coaches

- 1. Masks must always be worn while in the facility
- 2. Temperature will be checked prior to entering the facility
- 3. A small hospitality is expected to be available for the Coaches. It will not be the same as in previous years but grab and go snacks will be available. Location of Hospitality is TBD
- 4. You will not be allowed to stay in the building between events. If you have another skater already in the building, please alert the Usher.
- 5. Only 1 coach will be allowed per skater in the building.
- 6. You will be assigned a location to coach from during Practice Ice. Please honor that location.
