REGISTRATION TABLE

PRACTICE ICE TABLE

- Will open no less than 30 minutes before Practice Ice begins each morning.
- Additional practice ice may be available for advance purchase after the event schedule is posted at a cost of \$20 per 20-minute session, and will be communicated via email to all entrants.
- Practice Ice for Final Rounds is \$22/session.

MUSIC

- All music must be uploaded through EntryEeze by March 29th.
- Have 1 copy of your program music as a single-track CD in an mp3 format as a backup.

HALF ICE EVENTS

- Cones will be up in the center of the ice.

IJS CRITIQUES

FINAL ROUNDS

- Held Sunday morning for Juvenile Girls (12) and Intermediate Ladies (12).
- The top two (2) skaters from each group in their Freeskate event on Saturday will automatically qualify for final championship rounds.
- The remainder of the field (10) will be determined by the highest remaining Freeskate scores for that level regardless of group.
