

## 2021 ShopRite Nutmeg State Games Figure Skating Health and Safety Guidelines

Updated on June 27, 2021. Document subject to change.

The health and safety of our participants, staff and volunteers is paramount during the ShopRite Nutmeg State Games. The following guidelines were developed by the ShopRite Nutmeg State Games Staff, in consultation with recommendations from the CDC, host facilities, sport governing bodies and the local and state health departments.

## **General Health & Safety Statement**

The ShopRite Nutmeg State Games Figure Skating Competition will comply with all federal, state and local regulations as well as the recommendations of U.S. Figure Skating in effect at the time of the competition.

## **Event Protocols (updated policies are in blue)**

- ✓ The maximum number of Chaperones has been changed from 2 to unrestricted. Those who bought admission tickets in advance will pick up their bracelets at the ticketing desk. All others: Adults \$5 per person, Youth and seniors \$3.00, 8 & Under Free.
- ✓ Masks are not required for fully vaccinated people. All others must wear a mask at all times except for athletes when warming up outside or while Practicing or Competing on the ice
- ✓ All participants must **complete U.S. Figure Skating waivers online prior to the event**. Instructions on how to do this can be found here
- ✓ Anyone that is not feeling well, suffers from chronic or immunocompromised conditions or has experienced any COVID-19 symptoms (coughing, shortness of breath, fever, etc.) within ten days of the event should not attend.
- ✓ Anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within fourteen days of the event must produce written clearance to participate from a physician that confirms a COVID-19 negative status.
- ✓ Concessions will be available during the event.
- ✓ Photographs and video will be available to purchase at the event.
- ✓ The event will be live-streamed via LiveBarn as an additional paid service. More information can be found at this link: http://www.newingtonarena.com/Page.asp?n=104377&org=NewingtonArena
- ✓ Locker Rooms will NOT be available.
- ✓ Off-ice warm-up areas will be provided both indoors and outdoors for skaters.
- ✓ Results will be posted at the conclusion of each event inside the facility across from the Red Rink
- ✓ Medals will be given for  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  place finishers.
- ✓ Award ceremonies will be scheduled throughout the day. Awards may also be picked at the awards area at any time during the event if the award participant prefers.
- ✓ All music will be uploaded through Entryeeze. Skaters/coaches must bring a back-up copy of their music in CD format.
