**Arena Address: 519 18<sup>th</sup> Street, Oakland (crossroads are San Pablo & Telegraph)**

\*Back door entry on 17<sup>th</sup> Street, generally opens at 8 AM

### **PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION**

You can take BART to the rink. BART runs 7 days a week; however, Sunday schedule starts later in the morning. Get off BART at the 19<sup>th</sup> Street station. Exit by the 17<sup>th</sup> Street stairs, going toward Telegraph.

### **PARKING INFORMATION**

#### **Friday, Sept. 8, 2017**

- Parking Garage on 17<sup>th</sup> St: 7:00 AM – 7:00 PM  
\$2.00 per 30 min, \$16 daily maximum  
Pay at pay station prior to returning to car (before exiting)
- Parking Lot on 18<sup>th</sup> St (corner): 6:00 AM – 12:30 AM  
\$2.00 per hour, maximum 4 hours  
Pay at pay station and leave receipt on dash  
\*Lot is monitored by the city; tickets issued for exceeding your paid time
- Meters: 8:00 AM – 6:00 PM (after 6 PM, parking on street is free)  
\$2.00 per hour, maximum 2 hours  
\*Meters monitored by the city; tickets issued for exceeding paid time

#### **Saturday, Sept. 9, 2017**

- Parking Garage on Clay St: 8:00 AM – 1:00 AM  
No charge to park  
This garage is between 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> on Clay, approximately 2.5 -3 blocks to walk to the rink (back door entry on 17<sup>th</sup>)
- Parking Lot on 18<sup>th</sup> St (corner): 6:00 AM – 12:30 AM  
\$2.00 per hour, maximum 4 hours  
Pay at pay station and leave receipt on dash  
\*Lot is monitored by the city; tickets issued for exceeding your paid time
- Meters: 8:00 AM – 6:00 PM (after 6 PM, parking on street is free)  
\$2.00 per hour, maximum 2 hours  
\*Meters monitored by the city; tickets issued for exceeding paid time

#### **Sunday, Sept. 10, 2017**

- Meters: Not in effect on Sundays; street parking is open to all  
You may park at any meter for free without time limit
- Parking Lot on 18<sup>th</sup> St (corner): No charge to park on Sundays  
You may park in any open space for free without time limit
