Arena Address: 519 18th Street, Oakland (crossroads are San Pablo & Telegraph)

*Back door entry on 17th Street, generally opens at 8 AM

EVENT ALERTS:

Saturday, Sept. 8 = Fox Theater Concert (across street from rink). Begins 8:00 PM, doors open at 7:00 PM

Sunday, Sept. 9 = Oakland Pride Parade & Festival on Broadway (2 blocks away). Begins at 11:00 AM.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION (BART to the RINK)

You can take BART to the rink. BART runs 7 days a week; however, Sunday schedule starts later in the morning. Get off BART at the 19th Street station. Follow the signs to the 17th Street exit and take the escalator on the right to Telegraph. Walk straight ahead off the escalator and you will be on Telegraph, less than a block from the rink. PARKING INFORMATION

Friday, Sept. 7, 2018

- 18th St. Parking Lot: Open 7 days a week / 24 hours daily
Corner of 18th & San Pablo \$4.00 per hour, maximum 4 hours
Pay at pay station and leave receipt on dash
*Lot is monitored by the city; tickets issued for exceeding your paid time
- Rotunda Parking Garage: 7:00 AM – 8:00 PM
Entrances on 17th Street \$4.00 per 30 min, \$28 daily maximum
Or 16th Street Pay at pay station prior to returning to car (before exiting)
- Dalziel Parking Garage 6:30 AM – 1:00 AM
551 16th Street \$2.00 per 20 min, maximum \$36 daily
(for building 250 Frank Ogawa Plaza; 5 min walk to Rink)
- Meters: 8:00 AM – 6:00 PM (after 6 PM, parking on street is free)
\$2.00 per hour, maximum 2 hours
*Meters monitored by the city; tickets issued for exceeding paid time

Saturday, Sept. 8, 2018

- 18th St. Parking Lot: Open 7 days a week / 24 hours daily
Corner of 18th & San Pablo \$4.00 per hour, maximum 4 hours
Pay at pay station and leave receipt on dash
*Lot is monitored by the city; tickets issued for exceeding your paid time
- Dalziel Parking Garage 8:00 AM – 1:00 AM
551 16th Street \$2.00 per 20 min, maximum \$36 daily
(Building = 250 Frank Ogawa Plaza; 5 min walk to Rink) *Note: website says parking is free on Saturday; sign does not currently indicate that. Please be prepared to pay just in case.
- Meters: 8:00 AM – 6:00 PM (after 6 PM, parking on street is free)
\$2.00 per hour, maximum 2 hours
*Meters monitored by the city; tickets issued for exceeding paid time

Sunday, Sept. 9, 2018

- Meters: Not in effect on Sundays; street parking is open to all
You may park at any meter for free without time limit
- 18th St. Parking Lot: Open 7 days a week / 24 hours daily

Pay at pay station and leave receipt on dash
