

Hi Coaches!

Here are some important notes regarding the Centennial Spring Classic on Sunday, May 15th! Sorry for the length but want you to have all the information for ensuring your skater has a positive experience at the competition.

- 1) There are NO COVID restrictions at this competition – skaters may have as many guests as they would like to have
- 2) Starting orders will be posted online on Friday morning – there is a link on the login page of the competition
- 3) Please check in at the registration desk to receive your coach credential – only skaters and coaches are allowed at the boards/rink door during competition
- 4) Please note on the attached rink layout the sides of the rink that your skaters will be on for their half ice events
- 5) We will not have glass pulled for this competition so you may stand at either the entrance door or the exit door during the event warm-up to speak to your skater – this may be a tight fit so please share the space so all skaters can speak to their coach!
- 6) Note that during competition, all skaters will enter the ice surface via the western-most door and will exit at the eastern-most door of the ice surface for flow purposes – ice monitors will put the next skater(s) on the ice when the previous skater(s) has completed their program(s)
- 7) All results will be posted online – there is a QR code on the back of your credential for the results
- 8) Please make sure that your skaters arrive 60 minutes prior to their event – we may run up to 10 minutes early
- 9) Access to bathrooms will be in locker rooms 3 and 4 in the East Rink and the restrooms in the West rink. There is no access to the bathrooms in the East rink for skaters/parents/coaches as these are reserved for volunteers and officials only
- 10) Skaters may warm up outside (weather is supposed to be nice) or in the designated warm-up areas
- 11) Locker rooms will be available to put on skates – doors will be bolted open. It is best if skaters come dressed and ready to skate with hair and make-up done
- 12) Locker rooms will be age banded and gender specific
- 13) Local Motion will be doing action shots only at this competition
- 14) Etched It will be doing medal engraving
- 15) Bottles of water and snacks will be available at the Awards Table for coaches as we will not have a coach hospitality room at this competition
