

Hi Coaches!

Here are some important notes regarding the 2022 Colorado Springs Invitational/Rocky Mountain State Games! Sorry for the length but want you to have all the information for ensuring your skater has a positive experience at the competition.

- 1) Centennial Skating Club is committed to the safety of our athletes. Please read up on all policies in the U.S. Figure Skating SkateSafe Handbook (<https://www.usfigureskating.org/sites/default/files/media-files/SkateSafe%20Handbook.pdf>)
- 2) There are NO COVID restrictions at this competition – skaters may have as many guests as they would like to have
- 3) Starting orders will be posted online on Thursday morning – there is a link on the login page of the competition. There is a QR code on the back of your coach credential that will link to this page
- 4) Please make sure that your skaters arrive 60 minutes prior to their event – we may run up to 10 minutes early
- 5) Please check in at the registration desk to receive your coach credential – only skaters and coaches are allowed at the boards/rink door during competition – **our ice monitors will report any coaches that are not wearing their credentials to the Chief Referee who will file an ethics report with US Figure Skating for each occurrence**
- 6) Please note on the attached rink layout the sides of the rink that your skaters will be on for their half ice events
- 7) We will not have glass pulled in the West rink so you may stand at either the entrance door or the exit door during the event warm-up to speak to your skater – this may be a tight fit so please share the space so all skaters can speak to their coach!
- 8) Note that during competition, all skaters will enter the ice surface via the western-most door and will exit at the eastern-most door of the ice surface for flow purposes – ice monitors will put the next skater(s) on the ice when the previous skater(s) has completed their program(s)
- 9) Access to bathrooms for spectators/coaches/skaters will be in the West rink. East rink restrooms are for volunteers and officials only in order to ensure compliance with SkateSafe policies
- 10) Skaters may warm up outside in the designated areas on the AstroTurf (weather is supposed to be nice) or in the designated warm-up areas inside the rinks
- 11) Locker rooms will be available to put on skates – doors will be bolted open. It is best if skaters come dressed and ready to skate with hair and make-up done
- 12) Local Motion will be live streaming and doing videos and action shots at this competition
- 13) Etched It will be doing medal engraving
- 14) Locker Room 4 in the East rink is Coach's hospitality.
