



Hi skaters and parents!

Thank you for joining us for the 2023 Colorado Springs Invitational/Rocky Mountain State Games! The competition is smaller than in past years so that is why the schedule is quite a bit different.

Here are some important notes regarding the competition! Sorry for the length but want you to have all the information for ensuring your skater has a positive experience at the competition.

- 1) Centennial Skating Club is committed to the safety of our athletes. Please read up on all policies in the U.S. Figure Skating SkateSafe Handbook (<https://www.usfigureskating.org/sites/default/files/media-files/SkateSafe%20Handbook.pdf>)
- 2) Starting orders will be posted online on Thursday morning – there is a link on the login page of the competition. All scores will be posted online at this same link and there is a QR code posted on flyers throughout the facility that you can use to access the results.
- 3) We will be live streaming the event again this year. Links are on the main login page of the competition site. Feel free to point relatives and friends to that link and make sure they know when you are skating and on which rink and which side of the ice. West Rink – Zamboni end will not be live-streamed.
- 4) Please make sure that you have your skater at the rink 60 minutes prior to their event – we may run up to 10 minutes early
- 5) Please check in at the registration desk when you arrive – note the location on the rink layout attached – it will be inside the East Rink Lobby
- 6) There are no restrictions on entry to the building
- 7) Note that during competition, all skaters will enter the ice surface via the western-most door of and will exit through the same door
- 8) Access to bathrooms for spectators/coaches/skaters will be in the West rink. East rink restrooms are for volunteers and officials only in order to ensure compliance with SkateSafe policies
- 9) Skaters may warm up outside in the designated areas on the Astroturf (weather is supposed to be nice) or in the designated warm-up areas in the rink
- 10) Locker rooms will be available to put on skates and will be designated as “Skates on” rooms – doors will be bolted open. It is best if skaters come dressed and ready to skate with hair and make-up done – we will have GREEN individual pop up dressing rooms in the east rink along the wall as you walk toward the stands from the lobby if you need to make a quick change in costumes.
- 11) Local Motion will be taking action photos and videos for purchase. If you want photos of your half ice events, please order them early via this link: <https://www.localmotionproductions.com/2023-events/>
- 12) Etched It will be doing medal engraving near the Awards area
