

ARCTIC FIGURE SKATING CLUB VOLUNTEER POLICY

JULY 1, 2022 – JUNE 30, 2023 MEMBERSHIP YEAR

Management of the Arctic Figure Skating Club requires many hours of volunteer time from each member family. For the 2022-2023 membership year, we will be asking each family to volunteer a minimum of 15 hours (7.5 hours for 2nd Club members/families).

The Arctic Figure Skating Club requires a \$75 (\$35 for 2nd Club members/families) fee from each family to ensure that volunteer hour minimums will be achieved. If you have fulfilled the volunteer requirement for the 2021-2022 membership year, you are not required to pay the fee for the 2022-2023 membership year. The fee will continue to be waived for each new membership year if the volunteer requirement was met for the previous membership year.

Volunteer hours can be entered into Entryeze by the club member as they are completed. A board member will review, verify, and approve any hours that are entered.
