The new club will maintain the name of **The Winter Club of Indianapolis**.

Membership: All club memberships for the 2021/2022 season will be processed through **The Winter Club of Indianapolis**. Indy Central member details was migrated to the Winter Club membership system to streamline processing of memberships for the 2021-2022 season. This is a great time to renew your membership for the new season!

Here are the next steps for renewal:

Step 1. Watch for an email from the Winter Club membership system to complete setup. All current Indy Central members **must** re-validate their email address and set an account password to complete the migration process. Step 2. After step 1 is completed, you can then renew membership through the [Winter Club entryeeze](#) system as an **existing member** using your validated email and new password.

We have included a summary of the merged Winter Club membership fee structure, effective for the 2021-2022 season:

FULL MEMBERSHIP:

First Skater (\$160)

Usually the primary skating member in your household.

Additional Skater (\$65)

For additional skating members in the same household.

Parent (\$65)

At least one parent of skaters under 18 years old must join, allowing an adult in your family to have a vote.

Collegiate (\$110)

A 4-year membership for skaters attending college.

Coach (\$35)

Judge (\$35)

Full membership includes full membership to U.S. Figure Skating, so that you or your skater can participate in sanctioned competitions and test sessions, and have access to all club activities. Members 18 and older will have voting privileges in board elections.
