

PBFSC Member Volunteer Policy Guidelines

The PBFSC is a non-profit, volunteer run, and member driven club. We cannot function without the support of our members, therefore all member families (not each member per family) are required to volunteer a minimum of 5 hours during the membership year, July 1 – June 30. Our most critical volunteer jobs are best filled ages 18+, however some can be managed by ages 13 and maybe younger upon approval. Volunteer hours can be earned at local test sessions, shows, competitions, exhibitions, fundraisers, the annual banquet and more. Additionally, if any family members have difficulties contributing hours, donations can be made towards different events e.g., silent auctions, bake sales.

Hours can be personally logged via our Entryeze site and will be overseen by our Volunteer Chair. Those that serve on the Board of Directors, Jr. Board or chair a committee have fulfilled their requirement by serving in these capacities.
