MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Membership Season, July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020

THE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION DEADLINE IS JUNE 21, 2019.

A late fee of \$25.00 will apply to renewing membership applications received the deadline.

GOLD MEMBERSHIP

\$450.00 (1st family member); \$200.00 each additional family member, (12 Volunteer Hours or \$300 Assessment)

A Gold Membership confers unlimited pre-booking ice privileges and includes: participation in all club activities at member rates, 4 tickets per family to the annual Ice Crystals Show, and one (1) parent membership. A second parent membership may be purchased for \$30.00. A Gold Membership is *required* for Qualifying competitors who wish to represent CFSC at Regional, Sectional, or National competitions. Gold Members are granted voting rights and <u>seniority is accrued at a rate of 1</u> year for every year they are a member, when CFSC is designated as the member's Home Club, and membership renewal is processed by the application deadline.

SILVER MEMBERSHIP

\$250.00 (1st family member); \$175.00 each additional family member, (8 Volunteer Hours or \$200 Assessment)

A Silver Membership confers pre-booking privileges of up to 6 sessions per week at the appropriate level, and participation in club activities at member rates. This membership is also designed for skaters who participate in CFSC's Synchronized Skating or Theatre on Ice teams. A parent membership must also be purchased for skaters under the age of 18. Those who designate CFSC as their home club receive voting rights at CFSC member meetings. <u>Silver memberships do not accrue</u> <u>seniority</u>. Skaters at this level who wish to represent CFSC are limited to standard track non-qualifying competitions (teams exempt) and/or Adult qualifying and non-qualifying competitions. <u>Silver memberships do not accrue seniority</u>.

TEAM MEMBERSHIP

\$210.00 (1st family member); \$175.00 each additional family member, (8 Volunteer Hours or \$200 Assessment)

The Team Membership is designed for skaters who participate in CFSC's Synchronized Skating or Theatre on Ice teams. The Team Membership category allows skaters to skate on team practice ice, confers pre-booking privileges of up to 3 sessions per week at the appropriate level, and participation in club activities at member rates. A **parent membership must also be purchased for skaters under the age of 18.** Those who designate CFSC as their home club receive voting rights at CFSC member meetings. Team memberships do not accrue seniority.

BRONZE MEMBERSHIP

\$125.00 (1st family member); \$100.00 each additional family member, (4 Volunteer Hours or \$100 Assessment)

A Bronze Membership is designed for skaters that meet the requirements for one of the following categories:

Learn to Skate and members up to Preliminary Free Skate. These skaters may pre-book up to 2 sessions per week on No-Test ice, and walk on to additional sessions at member rates. Team skaters are not allowed under this membership. Once a skater has passed their Preliminary FS test, they must upgrade to the Silver Membership. A parent membership must also be purchased for skaters under the age of 18. There are no voting privileges conferred with this membership. Bronze skaters may represent CFSC competing in Learn to Skate USA and non-qualifying competitions. <u>Bronze memberships do not</u> accrue seniority.

Collegiate Member: This is a four-year (consecutive) membership at a reduced rate for members enrolled in a college or university. Each athlete may receive this option only once during their skating career. Collegiate memberships are for skaters 18 years of age or older who wish to maintain U.S. Figure Skating (USFS) and CFSC membership, but are no longer skating full time. Collegiate members can participate in club activities at member rates but *cannot pre-book ice* or vote at CFSC membership meetings. *Collegiate members do not accrue seniority.* There is no volunteer requirement for this membership.

Associate Member: Skaters 18 years of age or older, not enrolled in a college or university, who wish to maintain U.S. Figure Skating (USFS) and CFSC membership, but are no longer skating full time. Associate members can participate in club

activities at member rates but *cannot pre-book ice* or vote at CFSC membership meetings. <u>Associate members do not accrue</u> <u>seniority</u>. There is no volunteer requirement for this membership.

PEWTER MEMBERSHIP

\$80.00 each family member; \$60.00 for skaters registered in Colonial Advanced Skills Classes (No Volunteer Requirement)

A Pewter Membership confers member walk on rates to *Learn to Skate and No Test members*, and the ability to pre book one (1) session per ice contract period. Once a skater has passed a U.S Figure Skating Test (Moves in the Field, Dance, or Free Skate), they must upgrade to a Bronze or Silver membership. A **parent membership must also be purchased for skaters under the age of 18.** There are no voting privileges conferred with this membership. Pewter skaters may represent CFSC competing in Compete USA competitions. *Pewter memberships do not accrue seniority*.

Pewter Members that are also enrolled in the Colonial Advanced Skills Program (Basic 5 and above) are eligible for a \$20.00 discount on the Pewter Membership fee. If the skater does not complete two sessions of the Advanced Skills program in the membership season, the \$20.00 fee will be due.

PARENT MEMBERSHIP

\$30.00 (No Additional Volunteer Requirement)

One (1) parent of each skater under 18 years old *who designate CFSC as their USFS Home Club* but hold a Membership type other than Gold, <u>MUST</u> purchase a Parent Membership. Additional parent memberships may also be purchased. Parent memberships confer voting rights when CFSC is designated as the Home Club. **Parent membership fees may be waived for any skater that refers a NEW member, once the new member joins as a Gold, Silver, Bronze or Pewter member.**

HONORARY MEMBERSHIP

N/C (No Volunteer Requirement)

This membership is a lifetime membership confirmed by a vote of the membership at an annual meeting upon recommendation of the Board of Directors. This special membership is awarded to a selected member honoring his or her contribution to CFSC. The membership is free and includes the right to participate in all club activities at member rates. This membership does not include ice reservation. Honorary members, who designate CFSC as their USFS Home Club, receive voting rights at CFSC member meetings.

OFFICIALS MEMBERSHIP

N/C (No Volunteer Requirement)

Official memberships are provided to USFS appointed officials who are eligible for inclusion in the Officials Directory of the USFS Rulebook and designate CFSC as their USFS Home Club. These members do not accrue seniority, may participate in club activities at member rates. Official members, who designate CFSC as their USFS Home Club, receive voting rights at CFSC member meetings.

****NOTE**:** Volunteer hours are per family, not per member. If there are two members of different membership types, the greater volunteer hour requirement must be completed to avoid the assessed fee. The volunteer assessment fee will <u>NOT</u> be prorated.
