- All full members over the age of 18 have voting privileges and may serve on the Board.
- All full members receive membership in US Figure Skating
- All principal full members will receive a subscription to USFS's *Skating* Magazine
- All memberships run from July 1st through June 30th and are renewed annually.

When you join OKCFSC, you are also joining US Figure Skating, the National Governing Body for the sport of figure skating. The USFSA provides the sanctioning required for skaters to test, compete, and participate in exhibitions while maintaining the eligible status required to compete at the Regional, Sectional, National, World and Olympic levels. 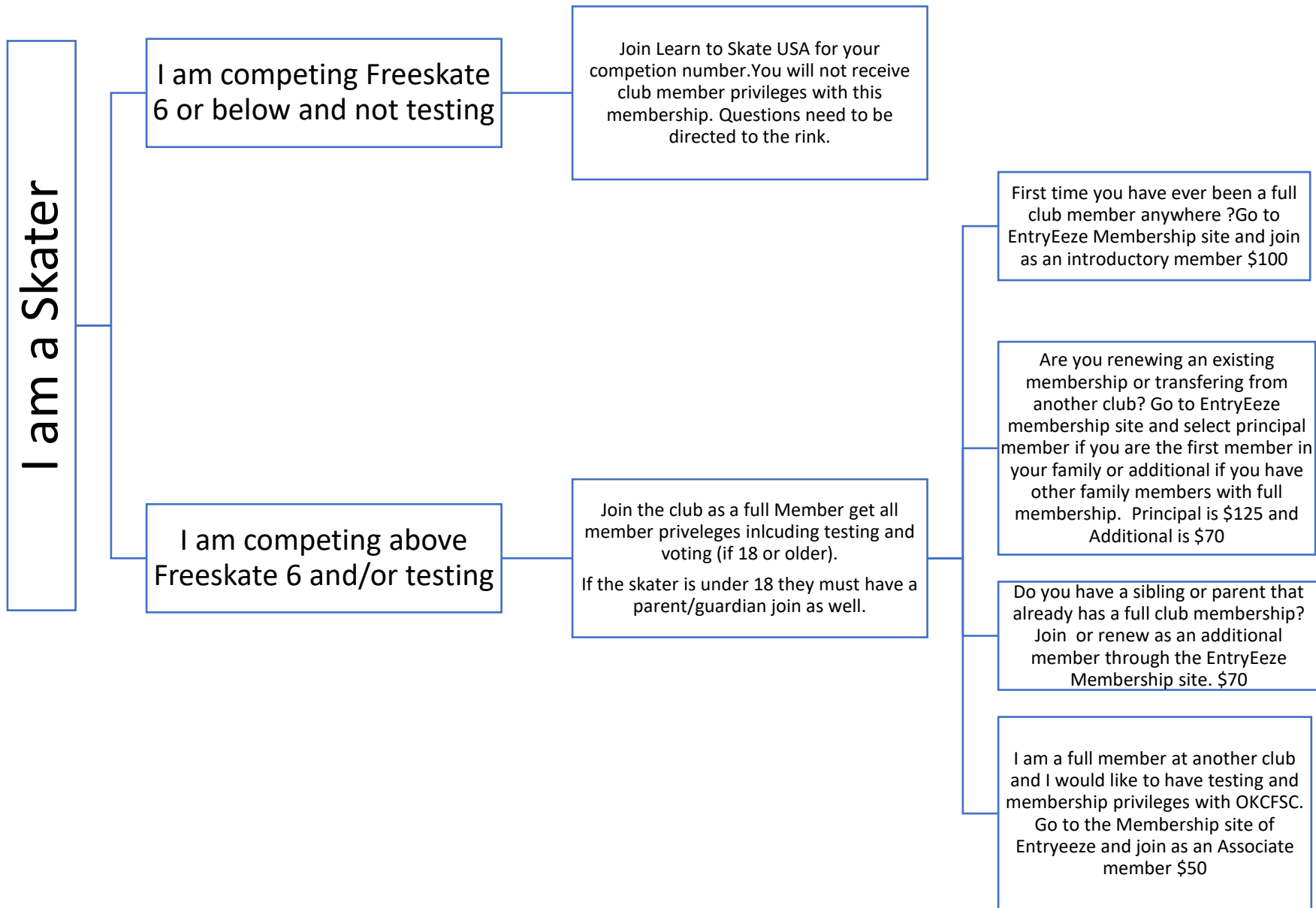

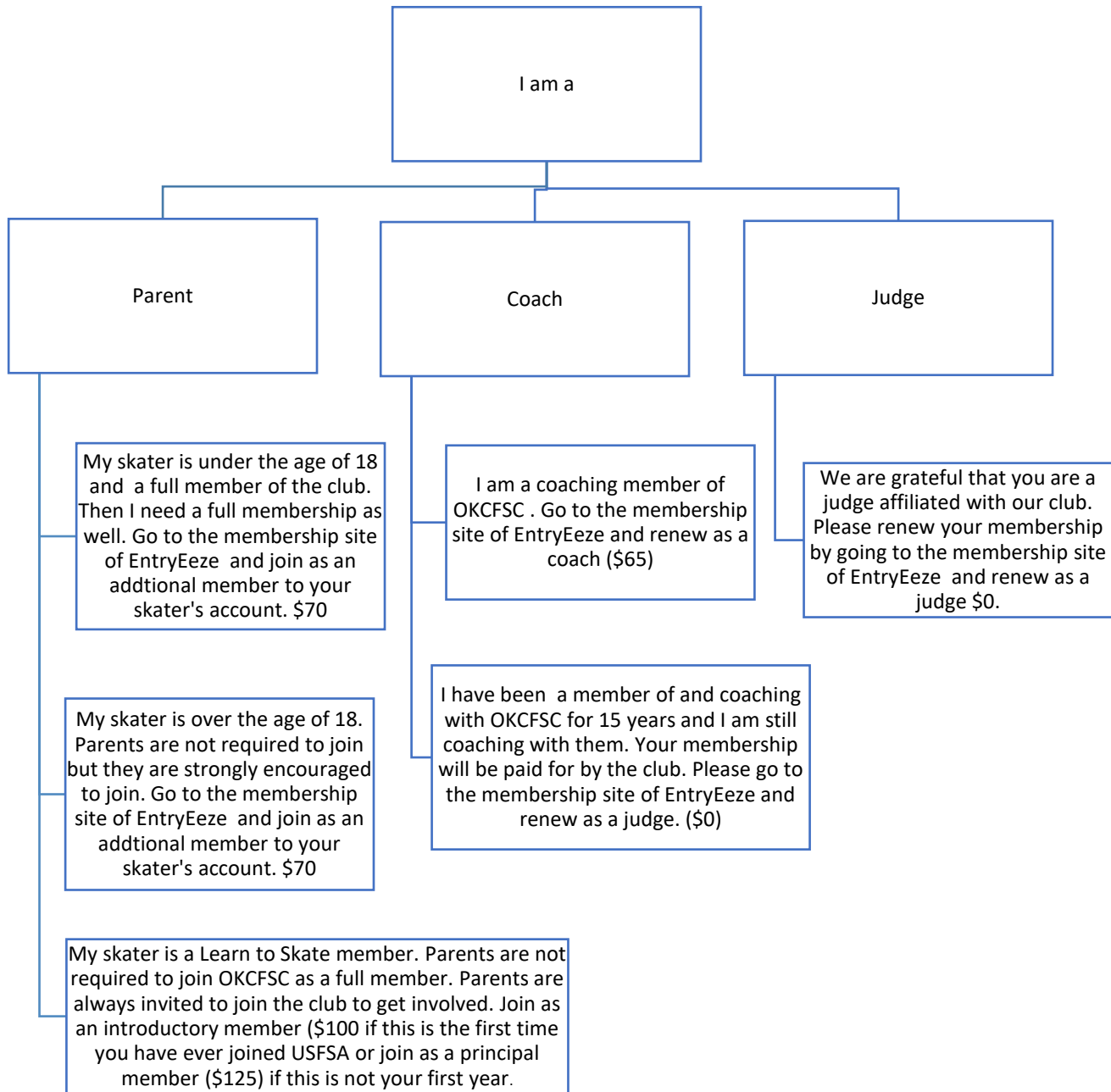

RENEWALS for existing Junior Members

We no longer offer this option. You will need to decide either to renew through Learn to Skate USA or join the club as a full member. See the membership flow chart to help you make your decision.

Option 1: If you are still just wanting to do basic skills competitions (Freeskate 6 and below) then you need to go to <https://www.learntoskateusa.com/> to renew your, what was your basic skills membership but will now be Learn To Skate, membership. This does not automatically get you into learn to skate classes, * Notice this new learn to skate number should be the same number you currently have just with an L in front. Please check with the rink front desk for more information.

Option 2: You can choose to join the club as a full member with all benefits. The very first year you do this you qualify for the introductory price which is discounted. * Notice this membership requires that if you are under 18 a parent/guardian also join as full member. (Cost would be approximately \$100 introductory member + \$ 70 parent member = Total \$170)

RENEWALS for existing full club members

NOTE: If you are adding a new skater to an existing family, renew current members first. Then add new family member following Registration instructions that follow below.

1. Go to our Membership site at <http://comp.entryeeze.com/Membership/Welcome.aspx?cid=180>
2. Click on Access My Account and login with email address and password. • Follow steps to reset password if forgotten. Record new password. • If you have technical issues and cannot login, contact okcmembership@gmail.com
3. Click RENEW (begin with Primary member).
4. Ensure all personal information is current; update as needed.
5. Provide coach information, if applicable.
6. IMPORTANT: from drop down box, select correct Membership Type for renewal. • Refer to this Planning Form , membership flow chart or the descriptions provided on the site.
7. IMPORTANT: fully read and “sign” Mandatory Volunteer Requirements.
8. Read and “sign” Waiver and Release, and Consent.
9. Repeat this process until all members in family have been renewed.
10. Go to Shopping Cart and process payment for renewals and selected merchandise. Renewal will not be completed until payment is made.

REGISTRATION for new or transferring full club members

1. Go to our Membership site at <http://comp.entryeeze.com/Membership/Welcome.aspx?cid=180>
2. Click on Apply for Membership (New Members) and follow proper prompts.
3. Enter personal information. If you do not have a USFS or Basic Skills #, leave this blank (you will receive one later). If you have ever had a USFSA or a LTS number please use that number. If you don't put that number then there is a possibility you will be assigned a new number which could cause problems later in your skating career.
4. Once your account has been established, you will receive an email to validate your account.
5. Validate account with link in email, Login and create password (record it somewhere).
6. If there is an additional family member, "Add New Family Member" and follow prompts.
7. Once personal information is recorded for all family members, click on APPLY/RENEW tab.
8. Select correct Membership Type for each person. (IMPORTANT: Refer to this Planning Form or the descriptions provided on the site.)
9. IMPORTANT: fully read and "sign" Mandatory Volunteer Requirements.
10. Read and "sign" Waiver and Release, and Consent.
11. Repeat this process until all family members have been registered.
13. Go to Shopping Cart and process payment for registration and selected merchandise. Renewal will not be completed until payment is made.
