Tips/Rules/Information for Parents and Skaters:

- Please arrive 15 minutes early to lace skates and be on the ice when lessons begin.
 - **PARENTS if your skater cannot tie their skates be sure skates are tied prior to leaving the rink.**
- To avoid cold feet, change socks before putting on skates.
- All skaters should dress in warm layers. Clothes should provide comfort and freedom of movement. Layers should not be too bulky. Sweaters with hoodies are not recommended. No jeans for Pre-Free Skate and higher. Make sure pants are not too long to avoid tripping while skating.
- No gum, candy, or food is allowed on the ice. Water bottles are permitted and encouraged to be brought by skaters. All trash must be picked up by skaters prior to leaving the rink.
- Always check the bulletin board at Ice Barn for information.
