

Free Skate Program

Each free skate level is comprised of a variety of progressive skating skills, transitions, spins, and jumps — all of which build on the previous skill, providing skaters a strong foundation of all elements. Instructors focus on quality and mastery of skills.

Classes include a 15-minute group lesson with a Learn to Skate Certified Coach and 15-minute open skate for Pre Free Skate and 30-minute open skate for Free Skate

\$90 USFS Membership - *Membership includes ability, test at U.S. Figure Skating-sponsored test sessions, compete at the sanctioned event, participate in qualifying events, represent your club at regional, sectional and national events.*

**SLFSC, home club membership, includes a one-time only \$30 raffle ticket charge per family – the tickets will be distributed during the first few weeks of regular skating in October. If you renewed your membership in the summer or fall - your account has already been credited.
